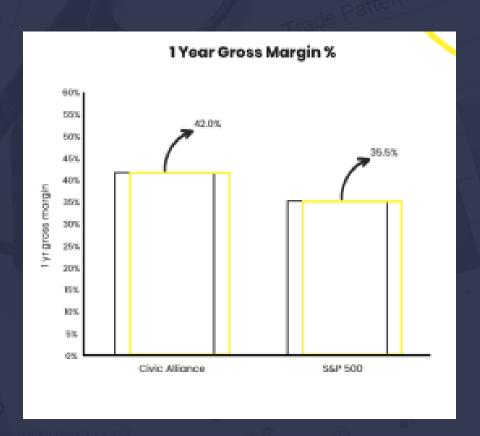


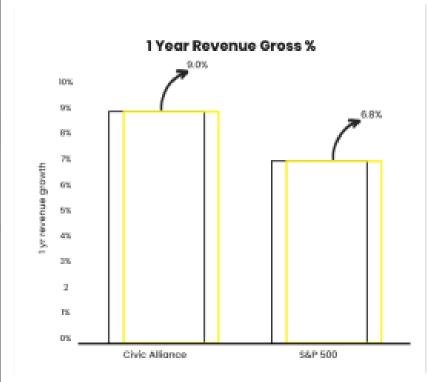

How a company empowers people to participate in shaping the affairs of their community and nation through the democratic process.

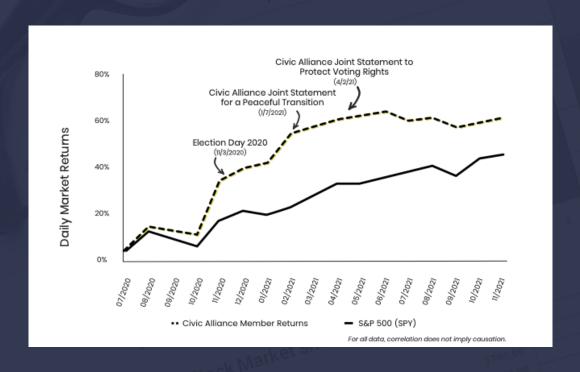
Company policies, practices, and communications—conducted without regard to political party, platform, candidate, or outcome.

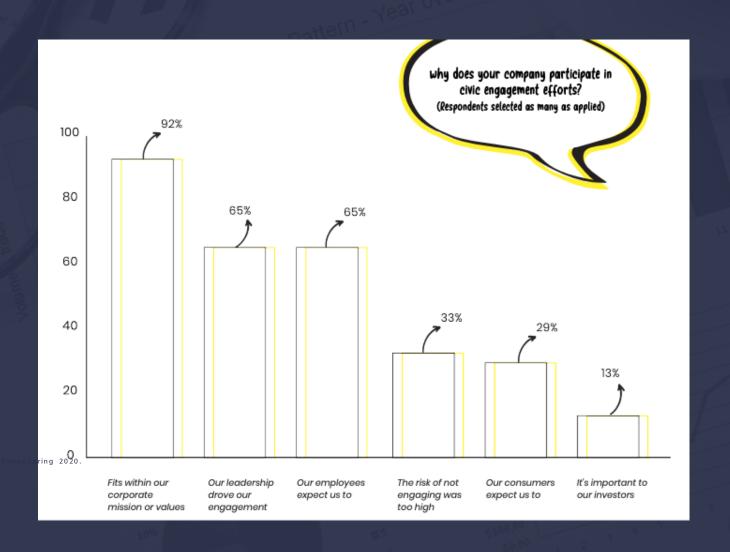
